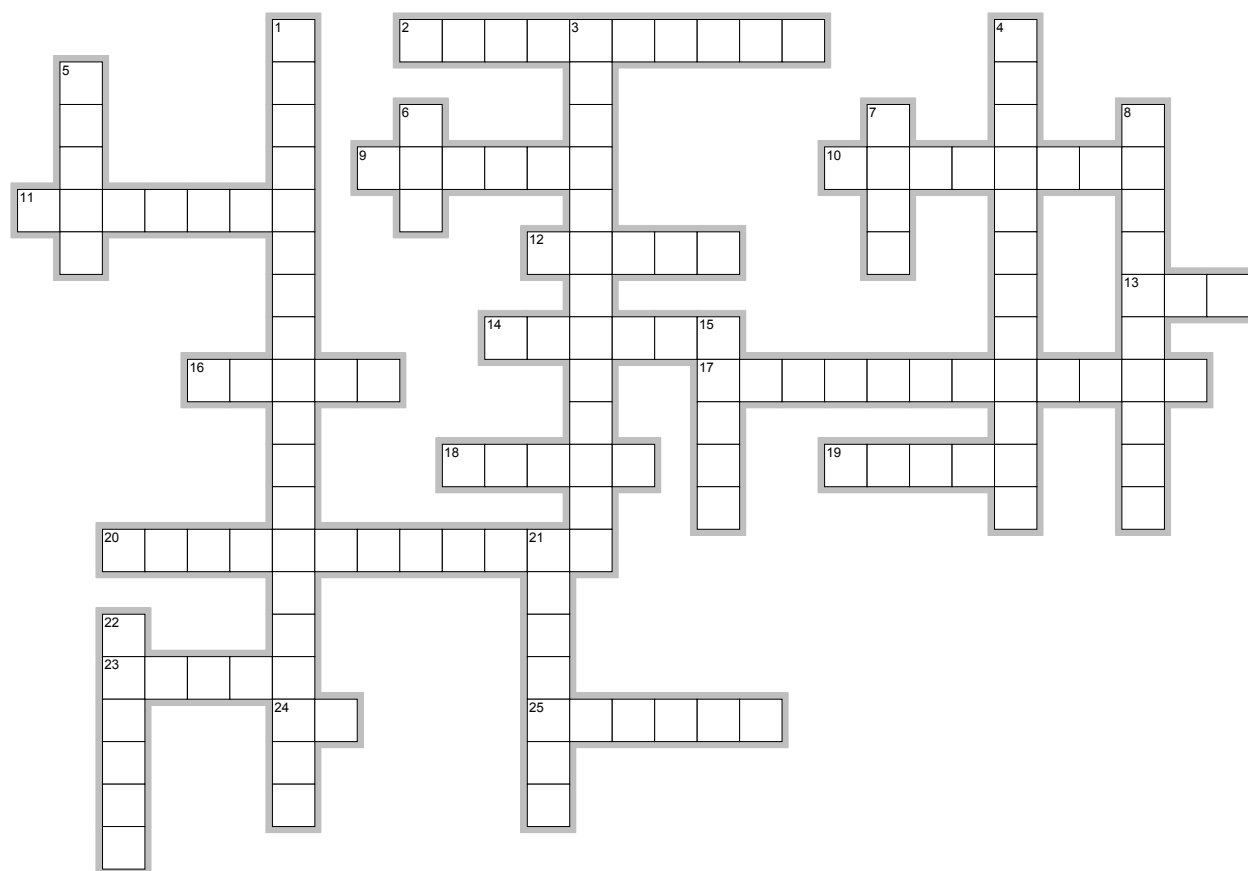


## Joshua - Part Two



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### Across

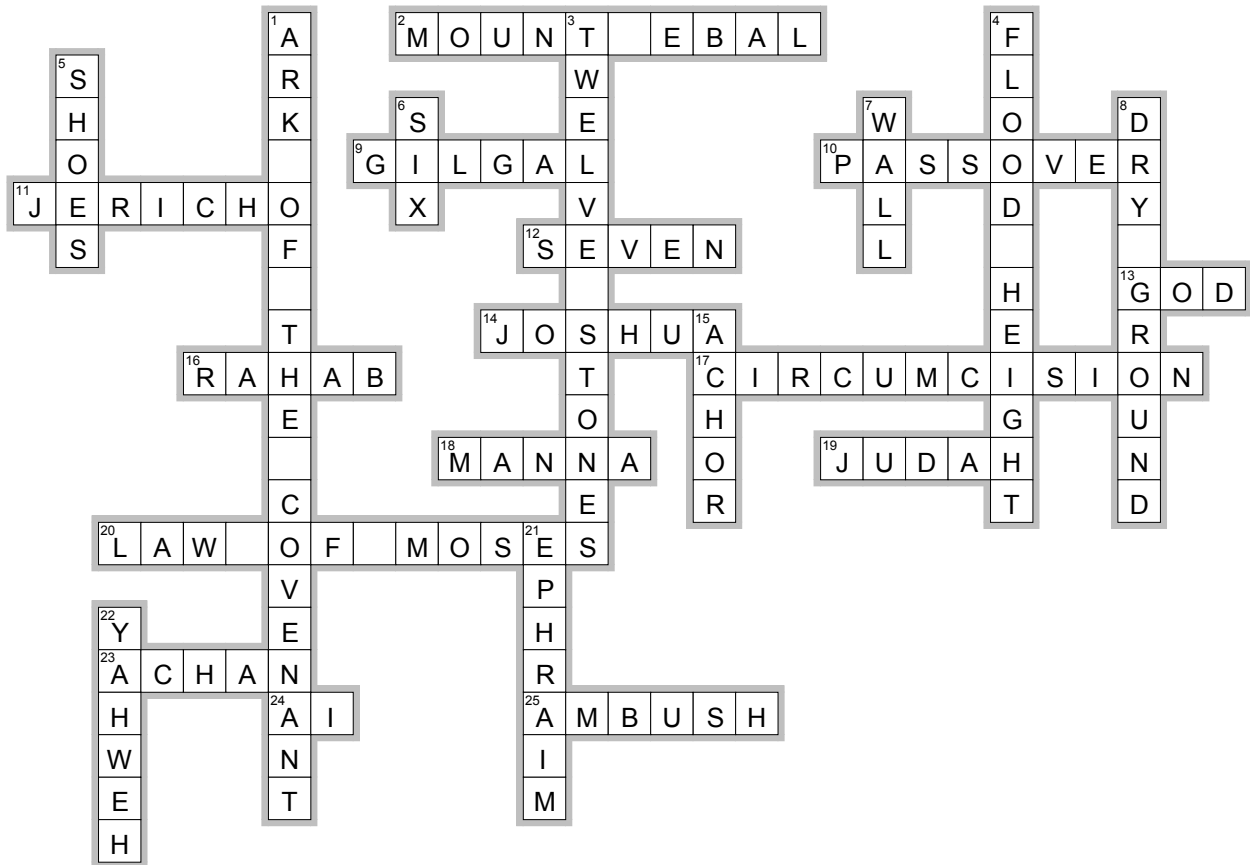
2. Joshua built an altar to the Lord, the God of Israel, at this location after winning their second battle. (Joshua 8:30)
