

Day 351 - Philemon; 1 Tim. 1-3 • Philemon is the most personal of all Paul's letters. Paul asked Philemon to impute or reckon Onesimus's debt against Paul's account. 1 Tim. 1-3 contains Paul's warnings against false doctrines, instruction regarding prayer, women, elders and deacons in the church.

Men are to lead in public prayer (1 Tim. 2:8). Women may teach as long as they do not usurp the place of leadership and authority of men in the church (1 Tim. 2:12).

Who instruction does Paul give Timothy in 1 Tim. 2:1-2?

Day 352 - 1 Tim. 4-6; Titus • 1 Tim. chapters 5 & 6 contain instruction in regard to various Christian duties.

List two principles you can learn from this passage involving money.

Day 353 - 2 Timothy • 2 Timothy was written by Paul from prison, knowing his death was near. Soon afterward, according to tradition, he was beheaded. Verse 2:3 mentions theme of this book - "a good soldier of Christ Jesus."

Per 2 Tim. 2:9-13, why did Paul suffer hardship like he did?

Day 355 - Jude; 2 Peter • 2 Peter 1:3-11 lists seven qualities that a believer is responsible to supply to their life, otherwise they will be rendered useless and unfruitful.

List these seven qualities.

Day 356 - Heb. 1:1-5:10 • The topic of Hebrews 1:5-14 is angels, but specifically how Christ is superior to the angels. Angels were created in a holy state, but some followed Satan in his revolt against God and became the demons. Angels are spirit beings, not bound by the same restrictions as humans.

In verse 1:14, who are those who will inherit salvation, and who was sent to render service for their sake?

Day 357 - Heb. 5:11-9:28 • The center portion of the book of Hebrews discusses the superiority of the priesthood of Christ. Jesus was not be a Levitical priest since he was born of the tribe of Judah. But, Jesus was associated with another order of priests, that of Melchizedek. Melchizedek is a type of Christ. Jeremiah 31:31-34 is quoted in Hebrews 8 describing the New Covenant that Christ mediates for the nation of Israel.

When will this New Covenant be fulfilled for Israel?

Day 358 - Heb. 10-11 • Many heroes of faith are mentioned in Hebrews 11. Verse 11:1 contains a definition of faith.

Per Hebrews 11:6, how does one please God?

Day 359 - Heb. 12:13; 2 John; 3 John • Hebrews 12:5-11 contains four reasons that Christians are disciplined by the Lord.

List two of these reasons.

Day 360 - 1 John • 1 John 1:9 is a verse you should memorize.

What is the standard established in 1 John 1:5-2:2?

Day 361 - Rev. 1-3 • The seven churches addressed in Revelation chapters 2 and 3 were actual churches of John's day. The church of Ephesus contained second generation Christians. They had sound doctrine but they had lost the devotion characteristic of a first love.

Rev. 2:7 mentions the tree of life which is in the Paradise of God. Rev. 3:5 provides comfort that believers' names will not be erased from the book of life. Rev. 3:10 is a promise that Christians will be kept from the hour of testing, ie. they will not experience the Tribulation. Rev. 3:12 is a promise that believers will be honored in Paradise. In Rev. 3:20, Christ appeals to worldly, compromising believers in the church. Rev. 3:21 is a promise that believers will sit down with Jesus on His throne during the Millennium.

What is the second death that Rev. 2:11 mentions?

Day 362 - Rev. 4-9 • Revelation 6 details the first of three judgments that will occur during the Tribulation. Revelation 8-9 details the second of three judgments.

Who are the 144,000 bond-servants that are sealed (protected) in Revelation 7 (during the Tribulation)?

Day 363 - Rev. 10-14 • During the second half of the Tribulation there will be intense persecution of Israel. In Revelation 13:3 Antichrist is miraculously restored to life, imitating the resurrection of Christ.

Who are and what happens to the dragon and his angels in Revelation 12?

Day 364 - Rev. 15-18 • Revelation 15-16 details the bowl judgments, the third of three that will occur during the Tribulation. In Revelation 17, Babylon represents the false religious system based in Rome. In Revelation 18, Babylon represents the commercial aspect of the revived Roman empire.

Who is the head of Babylon in Revelation 17-18?

Day 365 - Rev. 19-22 • Revelation 19 details the second coming of Christ, during the war of Armageddon. The beast (AntiChrist) and the false prophet are the first ones cast into the lake of fire. Revelation 20 details the Millennium, during which Satan is sealed in the abyss. The first resurrection occurs and includes all the righteous, who will reign with Christ for the thousand years that Satan is bound.

At the end of the Millennium, Satan is released from the abyss to make one final attempt to overthrow Christ, but only for a time before he himself is cast into the lake of fire. The judgment of the unbelieving dead is detailed in Rev. 20:11-15, where anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life is thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 21:9-22:5 details the New Jerusalem - the dwelling place of all believers. During the Millenium it will apparently be suspended over the earth.

What happens to those who are cast into the lake of fire, per Rev. 20:10?
